Dylan Blevins, Congratulations on his graduation from Basic Training; he is now a U. S. Airman.

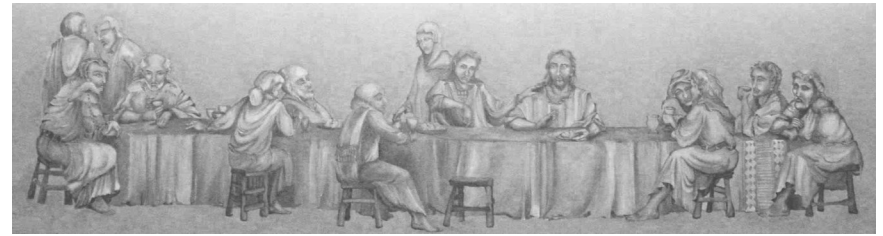
U.S. Army 2nd Lieutenant Caleb Findley, grandson of Helen Findley, attending Officers Training School, Ft. Benning, GA.
